Specialty mental health education for General Practitioners

Focused on delivering knowledge and skills for contemporary psychiatric practice, our Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Masters courses provide a person-centred, recovery-oriented approach to improving mental health and wellbeing of people in a range of clinical contexts.

Informed by research and practice with input from academics, clinical experts, consumers and carers, the Health Education and Training Institute (HETI) offers a world class program of study in Psychiatric Medicine, with flexible learning options to meet the evolving needs of doctors from different settings and specialisations.

The program integrates a recovery-orientation and biopsychosocial understanding of psychiatry and mental health with the CanMEDS competencies. This ensures that, as general practitioners, your practice will be aligned with the latest professional, consumer and carer perspectives on how to most effectively assist people with mental illness to live full and satisfying lives.

Aligned with the Five Domains of General Practice

Our courses have been accredited by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP). Associated workshops are accredited by the General Practice Mental Health Standards Collaboration (GPMHSC) and Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM). Our Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Masters courses in Psychiatric Medicine are designed and delivered to meet ACRRM syllabus requirements. Students will experience:

- Flexible participation modes.
- Expert seminars, workshops and tutorials.
- Participation in online activities.
- Detailed feedback on course assessments to enhance studies and professional progression.

Flexible access to study

Students can elect to learn at our campus in North Parramatta, through live web-video conferencing, online participation – or a combination of these. Students can study one or two units per semester, or undertake a stand alone unit of study.

Interprofessional Collaboration

GP students have the opportunity to enhance their ability to work interprofessionally through studying side-by-side with Rural and Remote specialists, psychiatry trainees and other medical practitioners. You will also study alongside a broader range of health professionals if you choose a Graduate Diploma elective therapy unit, or progress to the Masters research units.

New in 2018

To better equip students to apply course materials within your practice, HETI has introduced additional evening professional development web-video forums with our professional leads. Rural and Remote and GP students can also participate in any of the new supplementary sessions introduced to prepare for RANZCP training and assessments. Relevant activities include:

- Preparing for work based assessments and examinations.
- Preparing for and approaching multiple choice questions for success.
- Applying critical appraisal skills to examinations.
- Looking after yourself through the training process.
- Making the most of working with your supervisor and colleague.
