

Sequence for Older Persons Specialisation – GDAMHS 2022

Students commencing their GDAMHS are recommended to follow the sequence below. This sequence will suit those students who are comfortable with a study load of 600 hours across the one semester and three teaching periods.

Please note that specialisation units with a grey background are only available for enrolment within the select Teaching Period (i.e., 8ALF019 is only available within TP6 whereas 8ALK010 is available within all teaching periods). Based on this, you should choose your study path accordingly.
